PROBATIONER CLASS CONTACT

Probationers who are following the Teacher Induction Scheme can only be timetabled for a maximum of 0.82 of the week, i.e. 18.5 hours. A fully qualified teacher's contract allows for maximum contact time of 22.5 hours, 7.5 hours preparation and correction time (i.e. one third) and 5 hours average per week collegiate time as allocated in the Working Time Agreement.

It is recognised that Probationers will require time for mentoring, CLPL and local authority run sessions so their time is limited to a maximum of 18.5 hours per week contact time with pupils.

Probationers who are seeking full registration through the alternative route can be timetabled in the same way as a fully-qualified teacher although still paid on point 0 of the salary scale until they reach the Standard for Full Registration.
