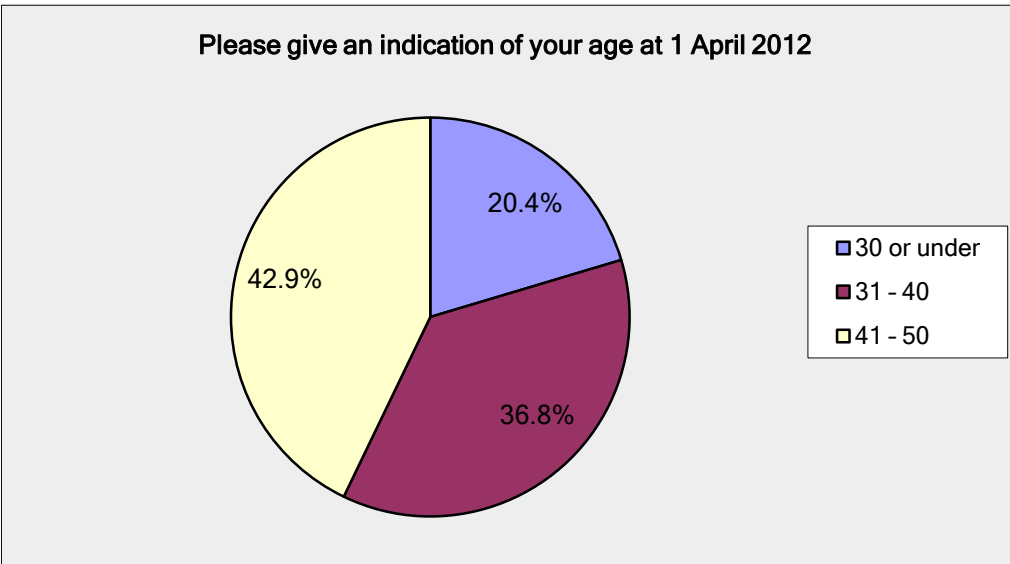


Survey on Pensions - October 2013

Members who were 50 or under on 1/04/12 were invited to take part in the survey. There was a response of 19.4%

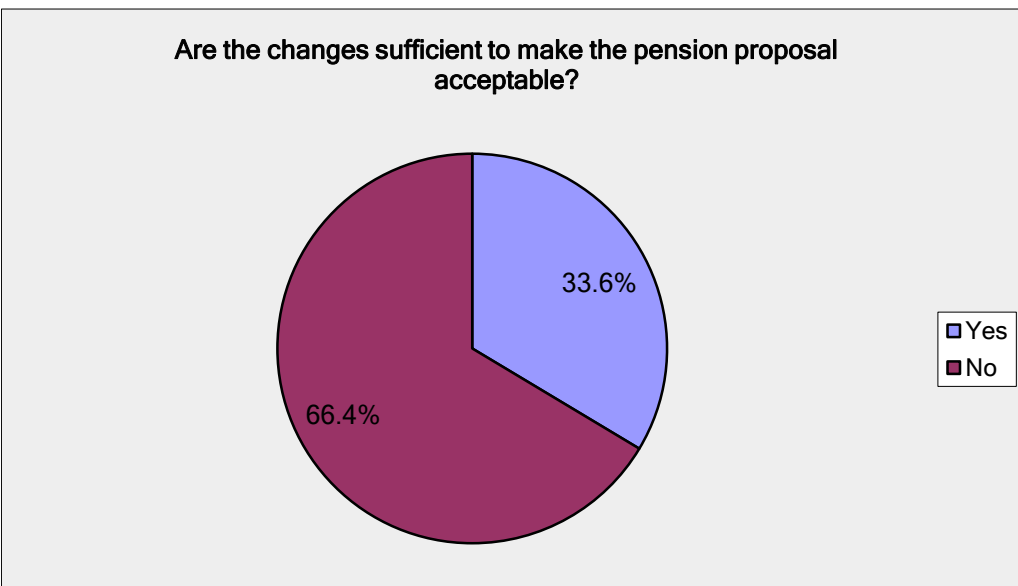
**Please give an indication of your age at 1 April 2012**
