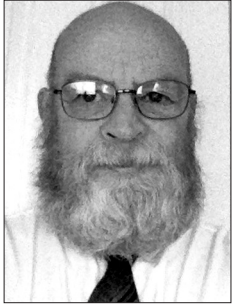




CANDIDATES' ELECTION STATEMENTS
